Programs also include: unified sports, which combines athletes with and without intellectual disabilities to form sports teams for training and competition; Meet in the Middle, which brings together students with and without intellectual disabilities to work on service learning projects and leadership activities; The Young Athletes Program, which teaches sports skills to all children ages two to seven; and Motor Activities Program (MATP), which enhances motor and sports skills for athletes unable to participate in traditional team or individual sports because of physical or behavioral limitations.
